ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATION - ready to use!

For anyone with an electric car, there is a new charging station at Town Hall on [10 Elm St.](#) in Trumansburg. The station is in the back of Town Hall and can accommodate two vehicles. To unlock the station, users will either need a [ChargePoint](#) account card or can call the number on the station. As part of the grant funding conditions, there will be no charge for the electric for the time being.
